Examples of Eligible OTC Items: Without a Prescription

- · Band Aids & First Aid Dressings
- Contact Lens Solution
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Diabetes Testing Supplies
- Insulin



Examples of Eligible OTC Items: That Require a Prescription*

- Allergy & Sinus Medicines
- Antibiotic Products
- · Cough, Cold and Flu Medicines
- · Pain Relief Medicines
- Acid Control Medicines



Examples of Non-Eligible OTC Items

- Cosmetics
- Toiletries
- Diapers
- Toothpaste/Toothbrush



As part of the Healthcare Reform changes, Over-the-Counter (OTC) medicine and drugs will require a prescription in order to be considered an eligible expense for the FSA.
